

# Script Analysis Checklist for Actors

## Scene Breakdown

- Identify scene function (Exposition, conflict, resolution).
- Understand context: location, time, circumstances.
- Spot emotional turning points and subtext.

## Dialogue Analysis

- Recognize character's voice, slang, rhythm.
- Identify subtext and hidden motives.
- Observe power shifts in dialogue.

## Action & Movement Cues

- Analyze actions reflecting mindset.
- Interpret body language & emotional gestures.
- Note stage directions & pauses.

## Relationships & Interactions

- Define character dynamics and stakes.
- Identify hidden motivations & conflicts.
- Observe relationship evolution.

## Emotional Mapping

- Map emotional beats and shifts.
- Show transitions through voice & movement.
- Ensure emotional authenticity.

## Objectives & Obstacles

- Clarify character's goal & importance.
- Identify internal & external obstacles.
- Note tactics for overcoming challenges.

## Applying the Analysis

- Make intentional choices in performance.
- Refine emotional authenticity in rehearsal.
- Experiment with timing & intensity.
